A — Excuse me, ma'am. I need your Russian address.

D — Of course, you do! And I'm so absent-minded. My Russian address is: 123423, Moscow, ul. Narodnoye Opolcheniye, dom 28, korp.1, kv.9.

A — And your daytime telephone?  
D-199-52-07.

A — Would you like to get your tickets now?

D — Now. Picking them up before the departure would be most suitable.

A — You may pick them up any time after 10.

D — Thanks a lot. You are very kind.

A — All the best! You are welcome any time!
