Henry VII (1491-1547)

King of England and Ireland he personifies the transition from the Middle Ages to modern times. He succeeded in unifying the country, in abolishing

Papal jurisdiction and obtaining what he desired from Parliament. He may be remembered for the birth of the English naval power, the dissolution of the monasteries and the death penalty for wives and friends.

Elizabeth I (1533-1603)

Queen of England and Ireland, she was born at Greenwich Palace, the only child of Henry VIII and Anne Boleyn. The

Spanish ambassador remarked that «she gives her orders and has her way as absolutely as her father did». She kept close personal control over councilors, parliament, foreign policy, religion and was a leader in critical moments. In her speech before the troops at Tilbury, on August 8,1588, with invasion imminent from The Netherlands, she said: »My loving people...I know I have the body of a weak and feeble woman, but I have the heart and stomach of a king, and of a king of England too».

Queen Victoria (1819-1901)

Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and from 1876 Empress of India, she was tenacious, obstinate, and delighted in ceremonies and etiquette. She married Prince Albert in 1840. After their marriage, life at court quickly changed. She had nine children. In politics she established an intelligence service abroad and governed with talent. Her long reign contributed to establish a «democratic monarchy» and to consolidate the Monarchy itself.
