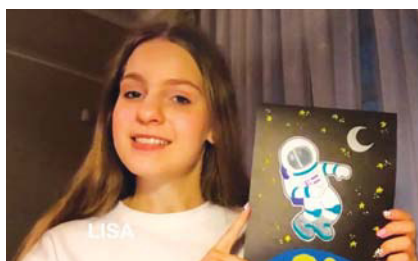

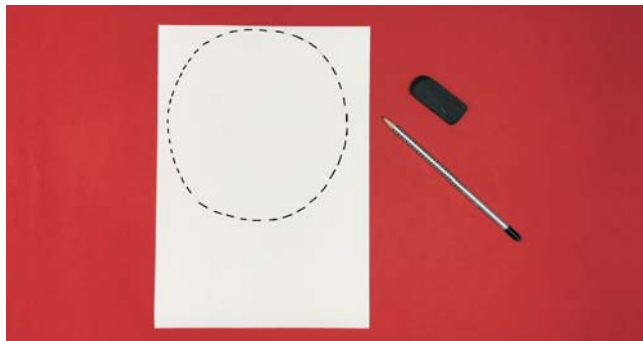
MOON

Hi,everyone! I hope you are doing great today. And in today's Arts & Crafts session we are making this beautiful artwork of the moon with a very interesting technique. For today you will need.

Palette, eraser, pencil, scissors, foil, blue and white paper, and paints.



First of all, you will need to draw a big circle on a piece of paper as you can see in the picture.



You can put away your piece of paper for a moment. Next, you need to take a piece of foil and crunch it, in order to make a ball. Make sure that one of the sides is flat.



Now let's go back to the paper. Take your paint-I've used silver,white and black-and put them on the palette. Make sure that you put enough, because we are going to use our foil ball as a brush.



Take your foil ball and put it into the paint. Next you need "to stamp" it.

The form of the foil will create a special texture of the moon. Make sure to cover the whole circle.



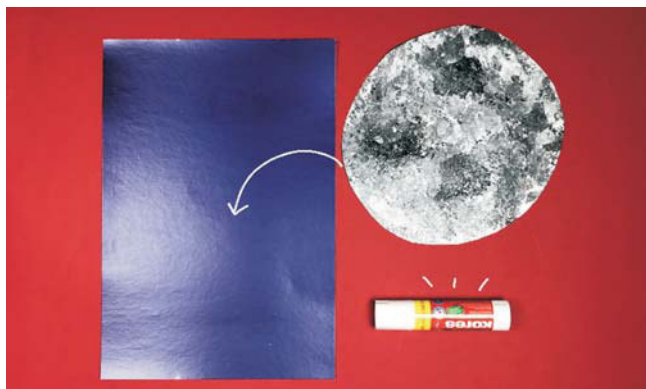
Next take your scissors and cut out the circle. If you can't use the scissors, please ask an adult to help you and be careful.



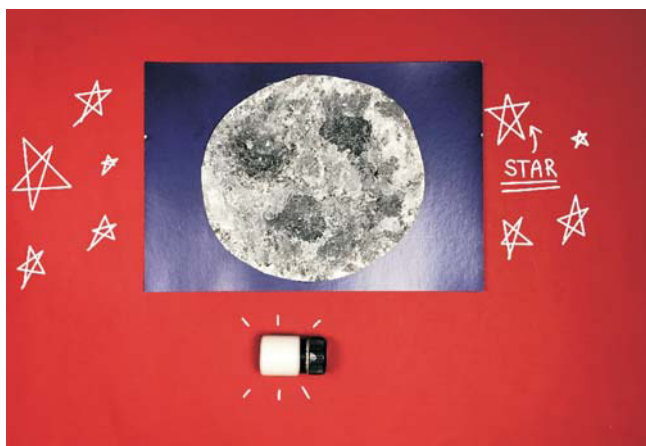


ПЫТЫ И ЭКСПЕРИМЕНТЫ

After cutting out, glue the moon on a piece of dark paper. I've used dark blue.



Next you will need to draw stars around the moon. You will need paint and you can use any color you want. For example: white or yellow.



I've decided to draw the flag of the United States. Because Neil Armstrong became the first human to step on the moon. American flags were planted on the Moon.



Last, but not least, you need to glue the american flag on your moon painting.



Congratulations, we are done! Now you have your personal Moon!

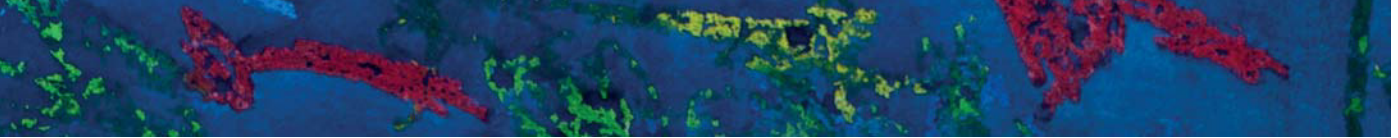


GALAXY

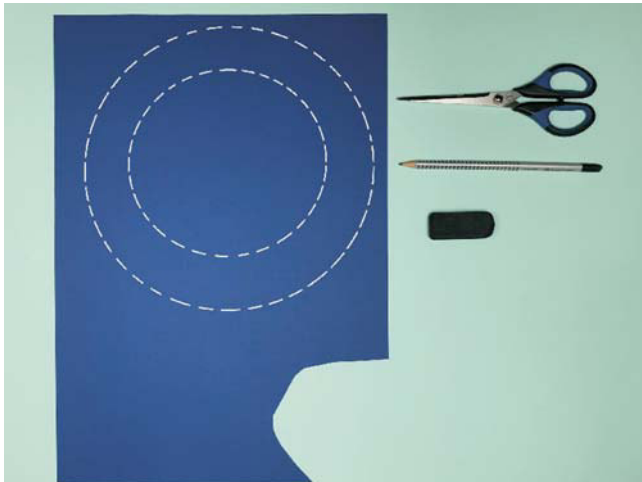
Hi,guys! I hope you are doing great today. I am Lisa. And in today's Arts & Crafts session we are making our own galaxy with our own planets, stars. Let's get started! For today you will need:

Eraser, pencil, scissors, glue, markers, blue & colored paper.





Okay, first you need to draw two circles on the blue paper. One circle should be bigger and another one should be smaller and inside the big circle, as you can see in the picture.



Next you need to cut out all the circles. In result, it should look like a donut.

If you can't use the scissors, please ask an adult to help you and be careful.

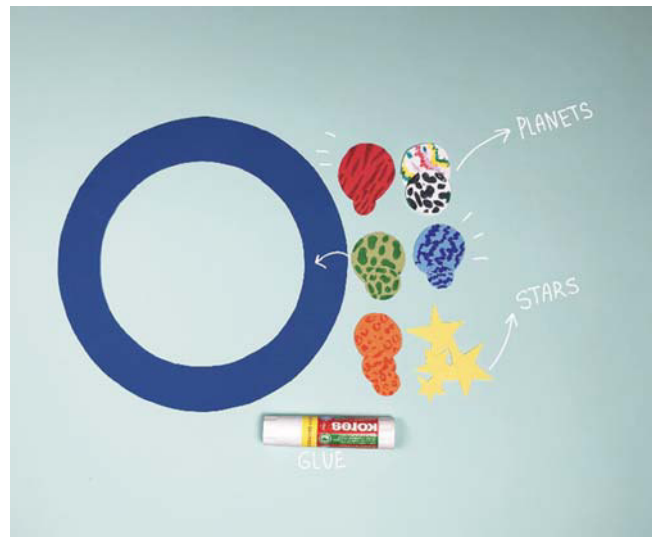


Now it is time to use all of your creativity and imagination. Take any paper you want and draw different planets, stars, etc. You can draw and color your planets on a white paper too. Next, you will need to cut them all out.



Last but not least, you will need to glue all of your planets and stars on the blue paper.

Before using glue, put the planets in the order you want.



Congratulations, we are done! Now you have your own galaxy!
